**DURING OUR MONTHLY POTLUCK SUPPER ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 24<sup>TH</sup>**, Calvary is privileged to host the CEO of the Union Rescue Mission of Los Angeles, who will speak to us about the problems of homelessness in the Los Angeles area. Andy Bales has devoted over 29 years to community outreach and service to those he describes as his "experiencing homeless friends". Established in 1891, the Union Rescue Mission has always been dedicated to serving the people in the Los Angeles Skid Row community.

Andy's present focus is organizing and working with community partners to decrease homelessness in Los Angeles by a significant number within the next 7 to 10 years. To better provide for the growing population of abandoned and poor women with children living in the downtown facility and neighboring hotels, the Mission has developed transitional housing for mothers and children at a center near Sylmar which also provides a permanent living facility for elderly women.

As CEO of Union Rescue Mission, he has had a pivotal role in reshaping hospital and governmental policies related to "dumping" of homeless patients from hospitals onto the streets of Skid Row. Among many other honors for his community service, he was named the 930<sup>th</sup> Point of Light by President George Bush in 1992. He has been featured on CBS's 60 Minutes, NBC's Dateline, CNN, to name a few.

We will gather at 5:30 p.m. for our potluck supper which will be followed by his talk. There will be child care and a program for young children. If you cannot bring a dish, come anyway. No one will want to miss this program!

**THIS YEAR OUR SIP AND STITCH MISSION PROJECT HAS DELIVERED** twenty-eight blankets to the Haven House for Battered Women. We took on a project to help supply baby blankets to the Neonatal department of the Huntington Hospital, and have delivered fifty-five baby blankets and sixty-three baby beanie caps per their request. We donated fifty lap robes to the Angel Interfaith Act of Kindness at the County Hospital, and after Christmas, we have blankets ready to label and deliver to the Door of Hope.

Since beginning our project in 2008 we have delivered 1,141 blankets. This is a phenomenal result for the women who volunteer their time on a Saturday morning. We are always looking for new people to help us. If you can't take three hours on a Saturday morning, several of our volunteers work at home, but they do miss out on the great fellowship.

Sermon Title: Brother Saul

Scripture: Acts 9:17, NT, NRSV

So Ananias went and entered the house. He laid his hands on Saul and said, 'Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on your way here, has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.'

But Paul decided not to take with them one who had deserted them in Pamphylia and had not accompanied them in the work.<sup>39</sup>The disagreement became so sharp that they parted company; Barnabas took Mark with him and sailed away to Cyprus.

Do your best to come to me soon,<sup>10</sup>for Demas, in love with this present world, has deserted me and gone to Thessalonica; Crescens has gone to Galatia, Titus to Dalmatia.<sup>11</sup>Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is useful in my ministry.<sup>12</sup>I have sent Tychicus to Ephesus.<sup>13</sup>When you come, bring the cloak that I left with Carpus at Troas, also the books, and above all the parchments.<sup>14</sup>Alexander the coppersmith did me great harm; the Lord will pay him back for his deeds.<sup>15</sup>You also must beware of him, for he strongly opposed our message.
