SINCE OUR PROJECT BEGAN IN 2008, SIP AND STITCH in total has delivered 912 blankets. This year in December we delivered 120 blankets and also 12 caps for the cancer ward at Keck Memorial Hospital's cancer ward. Lots of coffee, fifteen to twenty women, hundreds of skeins of yarn, thousands of knitted squares, and tens of thousands of volunteer hours plus donations from you from the Mission Market makes our project happen. This month we donated 50 lap robes to the Acts of Kindness project through the Angel Interfaith Network. Twelve blankets went to Elizabeth House for unwed homeless teenage girls. Fifty seven blankets and quilts went to the Door of Hope. They recently opened a third facility in Pasadena for Battered men and their children. The blankets are shared between the three facilities. Our goal for 2015 is to reach 1000 blankets. Without you and your donations this would not happen. Thank you.

ST. JAMES FOOD BANK IS PRESENTLY SERVING ABOUT 50 FAMILIES EACH FRIDAY. Every family unit is given the same bag of food items as well as a choice among extra things which have been donated. Right now they are in need of the following items which fill the bags given to everyone:

*(They prefer 15 oz jars since everyone is given the same size)*

- 5 to 7 oz cans of tuna
- 15 oz cans of fruit and vegetables
- small jars of peanut butter
- soup
- beans *(Not pinto, as they already have dried pinto beans)*
- chili con carne
- canned pasta *Spaghetti, etc. They do not need dried pastas)*
- spaghetti sauce
- macaroni & cheese
- plastic & paper bags
- hotel samples, especially soap & shampoo
- tooth brushes and paste
- eye glasses *(Prescription or dark, which they give to the Lion's Club)*
