Sermon Title: Truthful Stories

Scripture:

Luke 7:11-17, NT, NRSV

Soon afterwards he went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and a large crowd went with him. <sup>12</sup>As he approached the gate of the town, a man who had died was being carried out. He was his mother's only son, and she was a widow; and with her was a large crowd from the town. <sup>13</sup>When the Lord saw her, he had compassion for her and said to her, 'Do not weep.' <sup>14</sup>Then he came forward and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said, 'Young man, I say to you, rise!' <sup>15</sup>The dead man sat up and began to speak, and Jesus gave him to his mother. <sup>16</sup>Fear seized all of them; and they glorified God, saying, 'A great prophet has risen among us!' and 'God has looked favourably on his people!' <sup>17</sup>This word about him spread throughout Judea and all the surrounding country.
