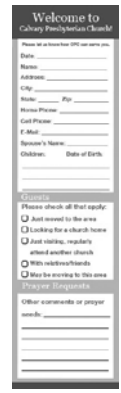

Title: "Where Mission Begins"

Date: July 19, 2015

Scripture:

Matthew 22:34-40, NT, NRSV

When the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together,³⁵ and one of them, a lawyer, asked him a question to test him.³⁶ 'Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?'³⁷ He said to him, ' "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind."³⁸ This is the greatest and first commandment.³⁹ And a second is like it: "You shall love your neighbour as yourself."⁴⁰ On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.'
