seek his presence continually.
- <sup>5</sup> Remember the wonderful works he has done,  
his miracles, and the judgments he has uttered,
- <sup>6</sup> O offspring of his servant Abraham,  
children of Jacob, his chosen ones.
  
- <sup>37</sup> Then he brought Israel out with silver and gold,  
and there was no one among their tribes who stumbled.
- <sup>38</sup> Egypt was glad when they departed,  
for dread of them had fallen upon it.
- <sup>39</sup> He spread a cloud for a covering,  
and fire to give light by night.
- <sup>40</sup> They asked, and he brought quails,  
and gave them food from heaven in abundance.
- <sup>41</sup> He opened the rock, and water gushed out;  
it flowed through the desert like a river.
- <sup>42</sup> For he remembered his holy promise,  
and Abraham, his servant.

his chosen ones with singing.
- <sup>44</sup> He gave them the lands of the nations,  
and they took possession of the wealth of the peoples,
- <sup>45</sup> that they might keep his statutes
