Title: "Puncture-Proof"

Scripture: Genesis 37:12-14, OT, NRSV

Now his brothers went to pasture their father's flock near Shechem.¹³ And Israel said to Joseph, 'Are not your brothers pasturing the flock at Shechem? Come, I will send you to them.' He answered, 'Here I am.'¹⁴ So he said to him, 'Go now, see if it is well with your brothers and with the flock; and bring word back to me.' So he sent him from the valley of Hebron.
