### HYMN NOTES OF CPC –3RD SUNDAY ORDINARY TIME

In memory of choral conductor Howard Swan

Our opening hymn is *All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name!* It was composed by Oliver Holden just after the birth of his first daughter. He named the tune *Coronation*. Oliver was a carpenter by trade. Three years earlier at age twenty one, he had moved to Charlestown, South Carolina from Massachusetts to help rebuild the town after it had been burned by the British. By 1789, he was once again home in Boston. He adapted a patriotic British text, set it to the tune and trained the choir for a civic ceremony honoring George Washington's 1789 visit to Boston.

*O Wally Wally* is our children's blessing. This tune is one of 4,977 English folk melodies collected by Cecil Sharp. Cecil, the most important of the English folk song collectors, was also an authority on folk dance. When Sharp visited America, he gathered and published tunes and dances of English origin from the Southern Appalachians. His work provided inspiration to composers of his day including Ralph Vaughn Williams.

Our meditation hymn is *Help Us Accept Each Other*. Fred Kaan, a staffer for World Alliance of Reformed Churches, wrote the text in 1975. Inspired by a Bible Study written for the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, Fred included several biblical references: *Romans 15:7, John 3:21, Ephesians 4:15, Matthew 18:21*. Fred sounds almost apologetic about the hymn ever being published. "It so happened that my 'Hymn on acceptance' was just of the right length to fill the two blank pages that needed filling." Others did not agree with his assessment. Doreen Potter wrote a tune for the text and called it *Baronita*. Church Women United featured the hymn in their World Day of Prayer Service. Today, forty years later, congregations continue to find his Hymn on acceptance meaningful.

Our closing hymn is *Lord Dismiss Us With Thy Blessing*. This tune was first published in 1792. At that time, it was sung in unison by crews of Sicilian seamen on board their ships when the sun set, hence the name *Sicilian Mariners*. The text is by John Fawcett. John at twenty-five was ordained in England as a Baptist pastor. He served one congregation at Wainsgate for his entire ministry. During this time, he wrote one hundred and sixty-six hymns most of them to be used following a sermon. In 1811, he was awarded an honorary doctorate from Brown University, Providence, Rhode Island.
