



### HYMN NOTES OF CPC –6TH SUNDAY ORDINARY TIME

In memory of choral conductor Howard Swan

Title: “Power Up”

Scripture: Eph. 1:18-20, 3:20 CEB

<sup>18</sup>I pray that the eyes of your heart will have enough light to see what is the hope of God’s call, what is the richness of God’s glorious inheritance among believers,<sup>19</sup> and what is the overwhelming greatness of God’s power that is working among us believers. This power is conferred by the energy of God’s powerful strength. <sup>20</sup>God’s power was at work in Christ when God raised him from the dead and sat him at God’s right side in the heavens,

<sup>20</sup>Glory to God, who is able to do far beyond all that we could ask or imagine by his power at work within us;

**Do you pray as sincerely for courage as you do for serenity?**

Our opening hymn is *Oh Worship the King, All Glorious Above*. This hymn tune, named *Lyons*, is based on scraps of melody borrowed from the Hayden brothers. The text is a loose paraphrase of *Psalms* 104. The arranger, Robert Grant, a political activist and member of the British Parliament, was born in Bengal, India. He wrote hymns as a change of pace from Parliament politics. In 1837, in memory of Robert, his brother published twelve of the family’s favorites.

*O Wally Wally* is our children’s blessing. This tune is one of 4,977 English folk melodies collected by Cecil Sharp. Cecil, the most important of the English folk song collectors, was also an authority on folk dance. When Sharp visited America, he gathered and published tunes and dances of English origin from the Southern Appalachians. His work provided inspiration to composers of his day including Ralph Vaughn Williams.

Our meditation hymn is *Arise Your Light is Come*. The Ecumenical Women’s Center of Chicago commissioned Ruth Duck to write the text in 1974. Ordained in the United Church of Christ, Ruth is currently an assistant professor of worship at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary in Evanston Illinois. She set her text to William Walter’s tune, *Festal Song*, first published in New York in 1872.

Our closing hymn is *A Mighty Fortress is Our God*. The tune and text were written by Martin Luther in 1529. Luther named the tune *Ein’ Feste Burg*. The harmonization is by Johann Sebastian Bach who used the tune in Cantata 80. Today there are more than two hundred versions of this hymn in common usage. Besides writing hymns Luther translated the New Testament from Latin into German and developed a German Mass.
